The sum of the days supply that fall within the measurement window for a statin fill for each patient in the denominator. Time Window: At any time during the measurement period (12 consecutive months)MPR Numerator:1. New users: For patients with no prescriptions in the 180 days prior to the measurement period, sum of:Days' supply of all medications from the first prescription until the end of the measurement period.**Remove the days' supply that extend past the end of the measurement period. 2. Continuous users: For patients with 1 or more prescriptions in the 180 days prior to the measurement period, sum of:Days' supply of all medications in the measurement period**Remove the days supply that extends past the end of the measurement period and add days supply from the previous period that apply to the current period

Patients 18 - 85 years of age with diabetes mellitus and at least one Part D claim for a statin.MPR Denominator:1. New users: Number of days from the first prescription to the end of measurement period.2. Continuous users: Number of days from the beginning to the end of the measurement period. Time window: Anytime during the measurement period (12 consecutive months)

- Patients with a diagnosis of gestational diabetes or steroid-induced diabetes who do not have a face-to-face visit with a diagnosis of diabetes in any setting during the measurement period (if medical claims (Part A/B data) are available).
