Patients who are prescribed* all of the medications, for which they are eligible, at discharge

All patients aged 18 years and older for whom PCI is performed who are eligible for any of the following medications (ie, patient has no contraindication, allergy, intolerance): • Aspirin • P2Y12 inhibitor (only for PCIs with stenting) • Statin
